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New opsi release 4.0.2 with Nagios Connector

Open source client management system now allows Software Rollout Monitoring using the standard monitoring tool Nagios.

The German open source service provider 'uib gmbh' releases a new version of its client management system opsi (open pc server integration).

opsi is a Client Management System for Windows clients based on Linux servers.

opsi integrates automatic deployment of Windows operating systems, automatic installation of software products and updates, multi-location support as well as a hard- and software inventory.

The new opsi release provides the ability to connect to standard monitoring tools like Nagios or Icinga to monitor the progress and results of software rollouts done by opsi. Also the opsi Nagios Connector can be used to monitor the opsi functionality of the opsi servers. Important is also that the 'opsi Nagios Connector' provides an easy way to integrate all the Windows clients to the monitoring by using the opsi-client-agent to provide monitoring information.



The 'opsi Nagios Connector' is an important step towards an integrated open source IT Service Management. Using it together with the existing OTRS connector KIX4OTRS, which is available by our partner c.a.p.e. IT, gives you a powerful integrated open source framework.

The Service Management Solution KIX4OTRS offers a neat and easy to use base to handle complaints, requests and service orders in Customer Service and IT Service Management. The new function CI-Admin-Modules allows to go over a selected PC working station of an IT user directly from the CMDB and to switch to the opsi management interface directly from OTRS.
