The German open source service provider uib gmbh releases a new version of its client management system opsi (open pc server integration).

opsi is a Client Management System for Windows clients based on Linux servers.

opsi integrates automatic deployment of Windows operating systems, automatic installation of software products and updates, license management as well as a hard-and software inventory.

The new opsi release focuses on stability and performance to meet the needs of large installations. Also there are enhanced possibilities to manage 64 Bit Clients. Beside these Highlights there is a large bundle of new features, which ease the daily administration business.

The core of opsi is distributed as open source without any license fees or subscriptions.

The development of new features like database backend and hierarchical client groups is



cooperatively funded. Until the cooperative funding of a new feature is completed, the new feature is available to paying customers only. Afterwards it will be part of the free open source release.

The easy to use graphical Management Interface is localized in English, German, French, Spanish, Dutch and Turkish.

Besides the opsi development 'uib gmbh' also provides workshops, training and support for opsi.
